BIKE

GREENER WAYS TO GET HERE

TRAIN

Our nearest railway station is Burgess Hill with regular direct trains from London and Brighton, serviced by Thameslink and Southern Rail. Travelling from London Bridge takes less than an hour and it's a mere 15-minute train journey from Brighton.

You can plan your trip, view fare prices and book tickets at National Rail Enquiries or the Trainline.

Once at Burgess Hill station, we are around a 10-minute cycle, 40 minute walk or an even-shorter taxi-ride away.

COACH

For larger groups, corporate events and private bookings, travelling by coach can be a cost-effective, carbon-efficient and sociable way to get here.

Local firm RDH Coaches offers competitively-priced coach hire with a commitment to 'cleaner and greener environment' – find out more here.

Or you can get in touch with CT Sussex Transport, a local charity providing community transport to those in need. They offer their fleet of vehicles for private hire to support the organisation's work and you can get in touch with them here.

ELECTRIC CAR

We've partnered with Porsche to provide three electric charging points in our visitor car park, so you can plug in and relax whilst you visit the vines.

GREENER WAYS TO GET HERE

ACCESSABLE TRAVEL

Forguests with accessibility requirements or living with disabilities (whether that's visible or hidden), we recommend that travelling by taxi. If you're able to leave your car behind, it's the best way to visit us in a comfortable and sustainable way.

If you're travelling from Brighton, 202020taxis, CityCabs or BrightonTaxis all offer wheelchair-friendly and accessibility-focused vehicles with drivers who have completed disability-awareness training.

ON FOOT

For the energetic, Ridgeview is around a 30-minute walk from Burgess Hill train station.

ROUTE: Please allow 30 minutes for the walk. Turn right out of Burgess Hill Station on to Station Road. Walk up the hill, towards a mini roundabout. At the mini roundabout, stay right (third turning) on Keymer Road, past Burgess Hill School for Girls for approx. 0.3 miles until you reach a mini-roundabout. Turn left at the roundabout onto Folders Lane and continue for approx. 0.8 miles. Turn right into a public footpath approx. 50 yds after Stroudly Lane. Follow this footpath until you reach Ridgeview Wine Estate where a warm welcome awaits! Please wear appropriate footwear, as the footpath can get very muddy.


Wherever you're starting out, you can plan your own walking route here.


TAXI

Station Taxis offers advance booking in the local area.

Or you can hail a cab from their taxi rank just outside of Burgess Hill train station. It takes about ten minutes to get to us at Ridgeview.
